

# COVID-19 Personal Property Addendum

## MRSD Board Policies

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Molalla River School District recognizes the unique dynamic around personal property during the COVID-19 Pandemic. Students may bring personal items to school as per existing district policies, but should limit items to those that are necessary for the day or immediately after school. This may include books, technology, instruments, food and medical supplies and water bottles, for example.

Personal Property should all be effectively labeled, with exceptions of instruments, athletics and medical supplies, should be kept on student's person, in a backpack or locker.

### Technology

Students will need to transport appropriate technology to and from school if they require the use of their assigned Chromebook during the course of the day. The student's technology should be marked with their name. Student personal devices such as cell phone, earbuds or other items must be kept on student's person and follow existing personal communication device policies.

### Books

Student should limit books to the items needed for that day. Books should preferably be kept in lockers or backpacks, expect when in use.

### Instruments

Instruments should be labeled with the student's name and taken to designated located upon arrival to school. Appropriate hygiene measures should be taken as directed by band instructor.

### Athletic Supplies

Athletic Supplies should be clearly labeled with student name and taken to designated location during the day following all rules and regulations assigned by athletic director.

### Medical Supplies

Medical supplies and medication may be only be kept on the students person if self-management and self-medication agreements are in place or if designated by students IHP, IEP or 504, under the approval of school administration and the district nurse. Other medical supplies will be maintained in the main office or designated location and fully marked with student name.

### Food Items

Food items should remain in students' lunch boxes, locker or backpack except during designated snack or meals times. If food consumption is permitted during the course of the day hand hygiene and sanitizing of personal space is required. Consideration must be given to food allergies within the classroom setting.

### Water Bottles

Reusable water bottles are encouraged to reduce the use of shared water foundations. Water bottles should not be shared between students. Water bottles should clearly have students name marked on the bottle.
